First Federal offers FREE Online Banking, FREE eStatements and FREE Online Bill Payment. Enjoy knowing you're in complete control of your financial picture, and that you can access your account information anytime and anywhere it's convenient for you.

STEP 1: Register for Online Banking

You must have an existing checking, savings, or loan account at First Federal to use Online Banking. Go to www.ffbh.com and click the 'Register' button located in the top right-hand corner of the site under Online Banking. Complete the Internet Banking Registration form. You will be prompted to accept First Federal's Terms and Conditions. Allow 1 to 2 business days for processing. Once your Online Banking is activated, you will receive a letter from First Federal with access instructions.

STEP 2: Register for eStatements

Instantly access your statements at your convenience. To sign up for eStatements, simply login to your Online Banking account, then select the 'E-Statements' button. Select the account you wish to setup with eStatements from the drop-down list. Click the 'Enter' button. You will be prompted to accept the Online Statements Services Agreement. After you have successfully completed the registration process, you will receive an activation email from First Federal, and will receive an email each month when your statement is ready.

STEP 3: Register for Online Bill Payment

Never miss a due date for a bill! Once you are registered for Online Banking, you may register for Online Bill Payment, which allows you to view, manage, and pay both paper and electronic bills. To sign up, login to Online Banking, click the 'Bill Payment' button, and then click the text link that states 'Click here to sign up for Online Bill Payment'. You will be required to fill out the Bill Payment Registration Form, and you will be prompted to accept First Federal's Terms and Conditions. Allow 1 to 3 business days for processing. You will receive an activation email from First Federal when you can begin to use Online Bill Payment.
